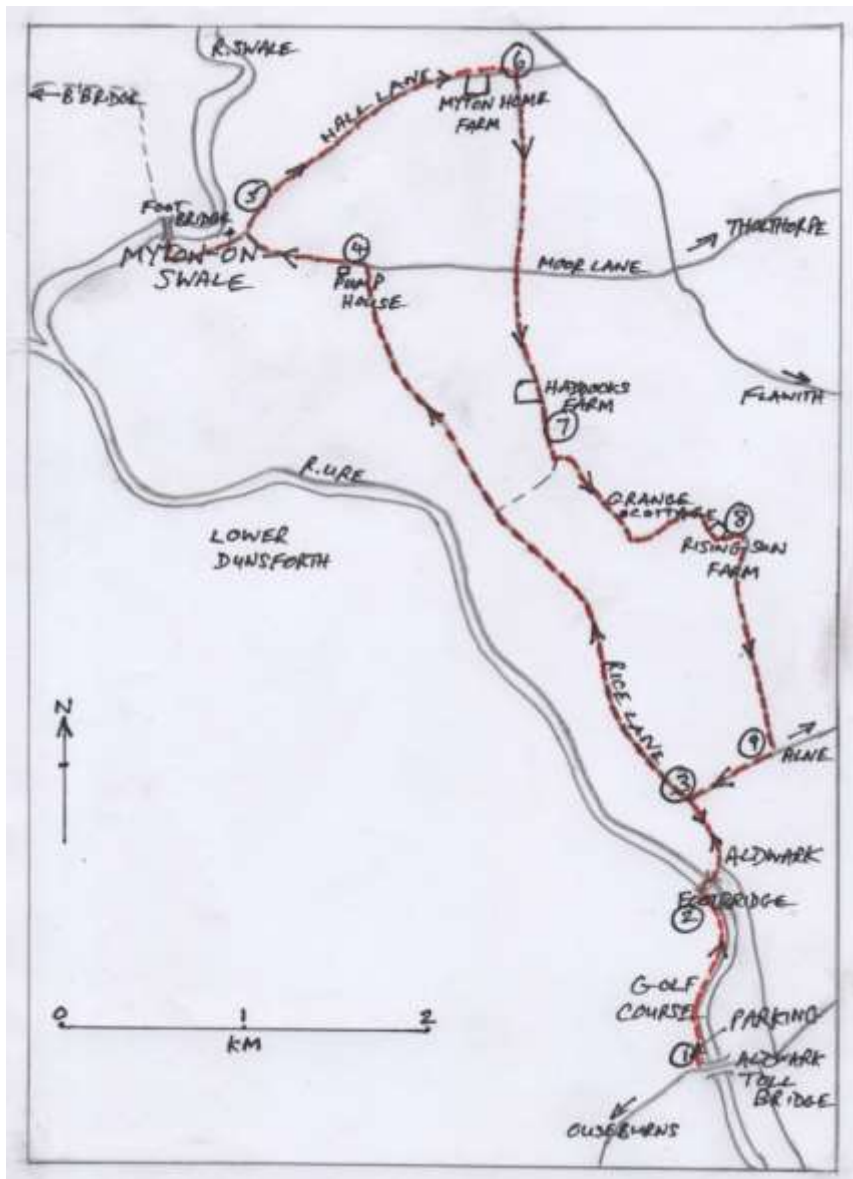


Boroughbridge Striders : Aldwark Toll Bridge – Myton-on-Swale Loop

- Start the walk at the parking area (1) next to Aldwark Toll Bridge and head along the river bank, on the edge of the golf course, to the footbridge over the river and into Aldwark (2)



- From Aldwark, walk NNW along Rice Lane (3) to Pump House (4); turn left and walk into Myton, if you wish
- On the return leg, take Hall Lane (5) and, when you reach Myton Home Farm (6), turn south along the path that runs past Haddocks Farm (7) and Rising Sun Farm (8). Turn left at (9) and walk a short distance along the road into Aldwark village
- To return to your car, either retrace your steps over the footbridge and through the golf course; or walk, with care, along the road which leads to the east end of the toll bridge which you can enjoy crossing at the end of the walk!

Distance and timing – the 16 km, very easy walk should take you no more than 4 hours, unless you include a break in Myton

Finally, although this is the simplest of walks from a route-finding perspective, it is suggested that you take a copy of the OS map (1:25000 Explorer 299) with you on your walk
