



PRESIDENT'S CUP (Club Triples)

Seventeen teams entered by the closing date (17 July) and have been drawn at random into 4 groups, three with 4 teams and one of 5, as shown in the table below. Each group will play a round robin, so all teams will play at least 3 games.

Because Group 4 has 5 teams, they will have to play an extra round to ensure each team plays 3 matches. Unfortunately, it means that one team will play 4 games (sorry Team Q!), but only 3 games may count in the league table, so they will be allowed to drop their worst result. To accommodate the extra games, we will need to start earlier at 1200, so that we can still finish by about 1800. Every group will also get an hour's break at some point during the afternoon.

Following the league stage, the winners of each group will contest the semi-finals. The winner of a group will be the team with the most points; if there is a tie, the result between the tied teams will decide. If still tied, the team with the greater shot difference and, finally, the higher number of shots scored, will go forward to the semi-final. Semi-Finals will begin at 1645, to allow time to calculate tables and determine the best runner-up, who will play the group winner with the best record, as determined by the criteria above. Teams may play in the order of their choice in the semi-final matches. The final match will take place on Finals Days, 07-08 September 2024.

One scorecard per match will be provided – please make sure both teams agree the final score before submitting it. To ensure that teams rotate position correctly, you **must** play in the order given on the scorecard for each match.

Games to start at 12.00 pm (Group 4) and 1.00pm for all other groups. Please be ready to play as soon as the signal to start is given for all matches.
