Periodic Electoral Review

A letter had been written to Mid Devon District Council following a discussion with R. Quick, District Councillor, about the attempt to move part of Nomaneland and place into Crows Marshland Parish, after consultation by Mid Devon Council the idea was dropped.

Changes to Planning Regulations.

Councillor Roger Quick gave a talk on the new planning regulations being brought in by Mid Devon District Council giving more power to the Parish Councillors on certain planning applications, namely, the pink sheet applications. These would only be a small proportion of applications but would enable the local Parish Council to speak at a Planning Meeting, either in favour or against as the case may be.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted as a true record.

The Precept: The Clerk advised the Councillors that the Council had a total of £439.74 in the Bank with only the Clerk's ^{part} salary of £100 to be taken before the precept would be paid in. It was discussed and agreed that we would ask for a precept of £550.00 to be claimed for the coming year.

Copy of letter written to M D Council. in connection with the Periodic Electoral Review.

Thank you for your letter of the 10th of Mar with documents enclosed, being the minutes of the meeting of the Policy and Development Committee held on Mon the 9th of Mar 98. Together with Annex A.B. and the Plans C. Resolutions J 849.

The area delineated on Plan C as being a part of Nonnewstead, suitable for warding and incorporating with Cray's Moorland, Cr Fitzpaine and Poughill, contains a population of Four Voters. We understand that the object of the exercise is to redress the imbalance between Cr Moorland and Thebridge: This proposal if implemented, would not make a significant impact on an imbalance which, we gather has been quantified at 60. There is a part or rather 3 parts of Nonnewstead, which are separated from the adjoining Parishes only by the unclassified road which runs from Hereford Cross in the South to Five Crosses in the North. However, if all three parts were warded with Cr Moorland, not much more than 2 dozen people would be involved. To achieve an acceptable balance, it would be necessary to take in the hamlets

of Stretchdown, nearly half way across the Parish
of Thelbridge, which we would find quite unacceptable,
it being fraught with implications for the very
survival of our Parish, and its Council, when the
Boundary Review people next deliberate on the
matter of Parish Boundaries.

We hope this is of some help when your
Committee discuss the matter on the 16th April.
