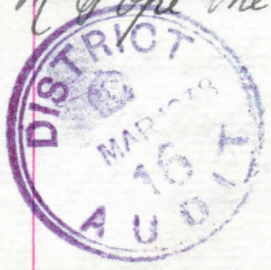

The Clerk was asked to write again calling their attention to it, also to ask if they could take off the corner at Mill Barn Cross where several accidents has occurred as no one cannot see a Car approaching one way. The sign Post has been laid on the bank for some time.

Church Road As the bit of road leading to the Church gate from the Worlington road is not repairable by the R D Council it was suggested if the Parish provided the stone, that when the Steam Roller was at Thelbridge to ask if they would roll them in.

The Parish has been provisionally allotted 25 Children accompanied, 25 Helpers & others making a Total of 50

Present was Mr Cole Chairman Mr Tully Mr Hayes. Mr Byrne. Mr Gilbard Mrs Jendall also attended who kindly canvassed the Parish to see who would take the children & others in that would be sent. she went to Mr say that the Parish would take 30 children & Mothers & babies Total 40

according to Mr Pope's Lists they proposed to send 25 children 25 Helpers & others Mrs Jendall considered the people in the Parish would not agree to it. so the Clerk was requested to write Mr Pope to that effect & ask him to amend his Lists & send the same as was requested.
