The community plan has been advertised on social media and the website – no response from either stream.

A parishioner has complained about the state of the roadside leading down to the cut, to the bridge over the river. Apparently, the leaves and accumulation of debris and rotting vegetation at each side of the road are encroaching into the road by approximately 1 meter on each side. This will of course lead to blocked drains causing the bridge to flood. Cllr Hughes logged this issue with "Do it online", the case reference is FS-Case -468104434. Although the Council have been up with the sweeper, it hasn't improved the situation.
