Appeal A: APP/C1570/C/22/3306591 Land south side of Mill Lane, Ickleton, Saffron Walden (southwest of M11 Junction 9A and east of the railway line) Boro Farm

Boro Farm dismissed and the enforcement notice amended and upheld.

The principle of the use of the land, noise, traffic movements, harm to the Cam, impact on the character and appearance of the area and biodiversity net gain are all matters the Inspector supported and dismissed the appeal upon.

The amended enforcement notice requires the cessation of the use within one month, the removal of all waste materials within 6 months, the removal of all buildings and mobile home within 7 months and the restoration of the land within 9 months, all from the date of this decision. Need to bear in mind the Appellant has 6 weeks in which to lodge a judicial review against the decision and it does not prevent further applications from being submitted.
