It is the (C) challengers responsibility to contact their opposition and come to a mutually agreed time and date

Aussie Pairs allows both people on a team to play Lead and Skip.
 In the first end of the game the Leads start off with 2 Bowls each.
 Then the Skips play their 4 Bowls.
 Then the Leads complete the end with their final 2 Bowls.
 Thus, the Leads act as Lead and Skip in the same end.
 In the Next End the roles are reversed.
 The Skips playing First with their Two Bowls.
