A letter was received from M^r Pope Creditor respecting men which worked on the farm & was out of work. it was found that they must be out of work for a fortnight & having applied for Relief. before they could be taken on. There was only one man out of employment. a letter was sent to M^r Pope accordingly stating two very dangerous corners one at the bridge cross to the other at the bottom of Hill Barton Hill. probably the owner of the land would consent if a suitable fence was erected. The corners have been brought before the County Council some time back.
