Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

NOTICE is given that the Kent County Council hereby proposes to make the above-named Order under Sections 81, 82, 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to: -

reduce the current national speed limit to 40MPH on the following road in Manston, Thanet:-

MANSTON ROAD – From a point 20 metres west of its junction with Haine Road for a distance of 680 metres in a westerly direction.

reduce the current national speed limit to 20MPH on the following road in Manston, Thanet:-

PRESTON ROAD – From its junction with Manston Road for a distance of 513 metres in a northerly direction.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82, 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as ‘the Act’) as amended, and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on XX day of XXXXXXXXXX 2025 and may be cited as “The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Thanet) (Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2022 (Amendment No.8) Order 2025” (‘this Order’).
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, “The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Thanet) (Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2022” (‘the Order of 2022’) shall have effect as though:
