Minutes of the last meeting on the 13th October were read by the acting Clerk and were unanimously adopted as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

Election of new Clerk. Joanna Gibson was proposed by Councillor Cole and seconded by Councillor G. Webber. It was noted that twelve months salary was due to the previous Clerk, Mr Ticehurst who had agreed a figure of £170. It was proposed by Councillor Hayes and seconded by Councillor Cole to pay this amount to Mr Ticehurst when the accounts had been audited.

Salary for the new Clerk was negotiated between Councillors and Clerk and will be confirmed at the next meeting. Such amount to be paid at Christmas.

District Councillor Quick suggested it may

be worth someone speaking to the Mid Devon District Council for some advice as to the customary position for payment of the Clerk's salary. District Councillor Quick offered to speak to the Parish Council Association.

Precept: Proposed by Councillor Boundy

That a Precept of £400 less £22 be made on Mid Devon District Council for 1994/95. Unanimous.

Housing Strategy; Private Sector Dwellings. It was decided that as Councillor Hayes and Councillor Gibson had already discussed the incoming letter M.D.D.C and concluded that no comments were necessary no further action would be taken.

Waste: It was noted that there was a bottle bank for public facility in the Thelbridge Cross Inn. It was agreed that the Clerk would reply to Associated Energy Products PLC indicating this and stating that for a small rural Parish no other recycling bins were necessary.

Any other business:

A balance of £3.54 was recorded in the deposit account and it was suggested by Councillor K Webber to ask for duplicate statements from the bank. Councillor Hayes agreed to go into the Lloyds Bank in South Molton as signatory.

It was noted that no insurance had been paid for 1993/94 year. Clerk to write to Cornhill Insurance for details. A cheque was signed for Hall rental and to be paid to H. Bear. 4 meetings. £24.

A request was made by Councillor Boundy that all old minute books, account books and the leather bag be returned from Mr Ticehurst.

It was noted that the lane at Councillor K. Webbers home had been repaired.

Clerk to write to D.C.C about hedges and verges at Millbam Cross and the water at Chapner Cross. Also to M.D.D.C with details of new Clerk.

District Councillor Quick noted that the Ayres' Planning Application had been approved. Also Raymond Gouvers following appeal.
