Owing to the death of the late Assistant Overseer it was necessary to appoint his successor. After consideration, Mr Gray proposed and Mr Hill seconded that Mr J Partidge (late of Upcott) be offered 12 £ a year to carry out the duties of Assistant Overseer & clerk to the Parish Council which he afterwards accepted.

It was also agreed to recommend him to the Commissioners as Assessor and Collector of Taxes for the same district for which the late Mr Chapple acted.
